Introduction

To support learning within science and to provide an exciting environment, the science department is responsible for notice boards along the “Science Corridor” and with the five science laboratories.

Purpose

- To display examples of pupils work and to encourage a sense of pride in their own work and the work of others.
- To encourage and maintain an interesting and pleasant working environment.
- To give value to the work and attainment of all students work.
- To present a scientifically stimulating visual display reflecting the diverse nature of science through recent history.
- To show an awareness of multicultural achievement within science.
- To support numeracy and literacy policies.

Guidelines

- Displays should be current and changed yearly.
- Students should be involved in the mounting of their own work.
- Displays in laboratories are the responsibility of the subject staff who usually teach in these rooms.
- Displays should always include Science rules and health and safety information.
- Displays should be of a balanced nature in terms of gender and ethnicity where possible.
- Each display should indicate the key stage or year of the teaching group involved.
- All work should carry the student’s name.
- Display work should be interactive where possible.
